#### **NALC**

A welcome letter to new and returning Councillors had been received from the Chairman, Ken Browse.

The independent Local Government Boundary Commission for England is asking for people across Nottinghamshire to comment on its draft proposals for new County Council division boundaries. A 9 week public consultation on the recommendations began on 9 June and will end on 10 August 2015. British Gypsum were conducting a trial along the A60 in response to complaints of noisy lorries in the early morning. Fernwood had agreed to a voluntary curfew of 30mp, not travelling in convoy and, where possible, would avoid sending empty wagons along the A60.
