CORRESPONDENCE

Nottinghamshire County Council

A commemoration fund was being offered by NCC to mark the centenary of the Great War. The Parish Council will not be taking up the offer as there have been no volunteers from the village who were willing to co-ordinate an event.

Rushcliffe Borough Council

A grant of £200 has been received to commemorate the centenary since the outbreak of World War I. A flowering cherry tree has been planted along the Ramper and a commemorative plaque will be added later.
