William Yarwood son of Robert and Alice of Bradmore bapt. Bunny 11 April 1642.

Robert Yarwood son of Robert and Alice of Bradmore bapt. Bunny 25 February 1644.

Richard Yarwood son of Robert and Alice of Bradmore bapt. Bunny 22 September 1646.

Gervas Yarwood son of Robert and Alice of Bradmore bapt. 25 February 1649.

Christopher Yarwood married to Elizabeth, resident in Bradmore 1650s.

Mary Yarwood daughter of Christopher and Elizabeth of Bradmore bapt. Bunny 7 May 1648.

William Yarwood son of Christopher and Elizabeth of Bradmore bapt. Bunny 11 April 1652.

Thomas Yarwood son of Christopher and Elizabeth of Bradmore bapt. Bunny 22 March 1657.

Robert Yearwood married Alice Looton both of Bradmore, at Bunny 28 July 1663.

Robert Yearwood married Isabell Streete, both of Bradmore, at Bunny 14 Sep 1669

John Yarwood son of Robert and Issabel of Bradmore bapt. Bunny 25 September 1670.

Mary Yarwood daughter of Robert and Issabel of Bradmore bapt. Bunny 2 June 1672.

William Yarwood son of Robert and Issabel of Bradmore bapt. Bunny 11 October 1674.

Thomas Yarwood son of Robert and Issabel of Bradmore bapt. Bunny 3 April 1676.

Alice Yarwood daughter of Robert and Issabel of Bradmore bapt. Bunny 5 March 1678.

Jane Yarwood married John Ward of Ruddington at Bunny 17 May 1680.

Gregory Yarwood son of Robert and Elizabeth of Bradmore bapt. Bunny 9 May 1682.

Mary Yerwood married Richard Hutton of Hough Lines at Bunny 16 Nov 1697.

YATES

William Yates, bapt. 18 Aug 1830 at E Leake, son of Henry Yates and Sarah Collins. 1841 age 11 tailor's apprentice with John Buxton and sons, tailors, at Bunny. 1851 age 21 single, tailor born East Leake, visitor in house of William and Elizabeth Whittaker, with their daughter Martha. Married Martha Whitaker 16 June 1851 at Nottingham St Mary's. 1861 age 31 tailor with wife Martha age 33 and son Arthur 1 born Ruddington, and Martha's mother Elizabeth 66 born Keyworth, at 2 High St., Ruddington. 1871 age 41 tailor with wife Martha age 43 and children Arthur 11, William 8 scholars, Elizabeth 6, Alfred 1 all born Ruddington, at Easthorpe, Ruddington. 1881 age 50, householder, tailor, married to Martha, with children William, Alfred and Martha, living on Far St. (Bradmore 1881/33). 1885/6 Whites Directory, tailor, also 1888 directory. 1891 age 61, tailor, married to Martha, living at Town End (Bradmore 1891/13). 1891 and 1893-4 received a ton of coal each year from Bunny & Bradmore Charities, 1894 Whites Directory, tailor, Electoral roll, house, 1886-1897, as William Senior. 1901 age 72, tailor workingon own account at home, with wife Martha and children Elizabeth and Martha, grandchildren William E and Caroline, on Village St. (Bradmore 19/1901). 1903 Received 1/p.wk from Bunny & Bradmore Charities. On 1900 Bunny Estate rental with cottage and garden as William Yates Senior, paying rent £4 pa, and on 1908 Bunny Estate rental as William Senior, paying £4 pa. Retired to Bunny almshouses. 1911 age 82, widower (married 55 years with 10 children, 5 dead), tailor on own account, in Bunny almshouses. Mr Yates the tailor lived at the top of Far St. near the old mill, sat cross-legged on a table top when working (J P Smeeton). William Yates born c1829 died Jun.qtr. 1916, Basford district.

Martha Yates, born 1829, Keyworth, nee Whitaker, daughter of William, ag.lab, and Elizabeth of Bunny, married William Yates at Nottingham St Mary's 16 June 1851. 1861 age 33 married to William, at Ruddington. 1871 age 43 married to William, at Ruddington. 1881 age 52, married to William (Bradmore 1881/33). 1891 age 63 married to William (Bradmore 1891/13). 1901 age 74, married to William (Bradmore 19/1901). Martha Yates born 1829 died Jul.qtr. 1905 Basford district.

William E Yates born 1900, Netherfield, grandson of William and Martha, illegitimate son of either Martha or Maud. 1901 age 8 mths in grandparents' house (Bradmore 19/1901). 1911 in Martha and Henry Smith's house – see below under Martha, described as son but no children from Martha and Henry's marriage; sister Maud also present.

Arthur Yates, born 1860, Ruddington, son of William and Martha. 1861 age 1 in parents' house at Ruddington. 1871 age 11 scholar in parents' house at Ruddington. Jul.qtr 1880 Nottingham district Arthur Yates married Caroline Lloyd daughter of Aaron, ag.lab, and Mary of Mountnessing, Essex. 1881 age 21, householder, framework knitter, married to Caroline, with son Harry on Far St. (Bradmore 1881/28). Electoral roll, house, 1886-1890. 1891 age 31 framework knitter with wife Caroline age 32 and children Harry Fred, William T 4 born Egham Surrey, Edith A, scholars, and Arthur 3 mths born Heanor, at Mount St, Heanor. 1901 age 41 lace bobbin presser with wife Caroline age 42 and children Harry, Frederick, William T 14 errand boy, Edith A 12, Arthur 10, Alexander R

6, Nellie V 4, Philip L 4, the last 4 all born Heanor, at 15 Abbot St., Heanor.

Caroline Yates, born 1859, Mountnessing Essex, nee Lloyd, daughter of Aaron, ag.lab, and Mary. 1861 age 2 in parents' house at Church Lane, Mountnessing. 1871 age 12 scholar in parents' house. Jul.qtr. 1880 married Arthur Yates, Nottingham district. 1881 age 22, married to Arthur (Bradmore 1881/28). 1891 age 32 married to Arthur at Heanor. 1901 age 42 married to Arthur at Heanor.

Harry Yates born 1881 Bradmore, son of Arthur and Caroline. 1881 age 6 months in parents' house (Bradmore 1881/28). Methodist Sunday School scholar 4th class 5.7.1885-June 1886, Aug.1886, Oct.1886-June 1888, 3rd class July 1888-4.8.1889, 22.9.1889-27.10.1889. 1891 age 10 scholar in parents' house at Heanor. 1901 age 20 lace maker in parents' house at Heanor. Jul.qtr 1901 Basford district Harry Yates married Annie Fulwood niece of Joseph Elliott, framework knitter, and Matilda of Heanor. 1911 Harry age 30 lacemaker born Bradmore with wife Annie age 32 born Newstead and children William Lloyd Yates 9, Annie Mary 8, Jessie 6, Harry 5 scholars born Heanor, Frederick 3, Nellie 1 born Long Eaton, at 169 Bennet St., Long Eaton, 5-room house.

Frederick Yates born 1885 Ruddington, son of Arthur and Caroline. Methodist Sunday School scholar 4th class 12.8.1889-17.11.1889. 1891 age 6 in parents' house at Heanor. 1901 age 16 lace maker in parents' house at Heanor. Jan.qtr. 1909 Basford district Frederick Yates married Elizabeth Beardsley, daughter of Thomas, foundry labourer, and Harriett (born Horsley Woodhouse) of Brightside Bierlow. 1911 age 26 coal miner below ground ("on the road") born Ruddington with wife Elizabeth age 26 born Horsley Woodhouse (married 2 years with 1 child), daughter Irene 3 mths born Heanor, at 5 Thorpe Rd., Heanor, 4-room house.

Edith A Yates born 1889 Bradmore, daughter of Arthur and Caroline. 1891 age 2 scholar in parents' house at Heanor. 1901 age 12 in parents' house at Heanor.

William Yates, bapt. 29 July 1862, Ruddington, son of William and Martha. 1871 age 8 scholar in parents' house, Ruddington. 1881 age 18, domestic servant, in parents' house (Bradmore 1881/33). 26 May 1885 William age 22 framework knitter of Bradmore son of William, tailor, married Alice Jackson age 19 of Bradmore daughter of Edward, labourer. 1891 age 28, framework knitter, married to Alice, children Maud, Rose and Annie, living at Town End next to his parents (Bradmore 1891/14). Electoral roll, house, 1890-1911 as William Junior. 1892 William Yates Junior recorded in Bunny & Bradmore Charities minutes as receiving a ton of coals, though no reference to William senior. In 1893 a ton of coals was granted 'if necessary' to William Yates Junior, together with temporary help in money if necessary. 1901 age 38, widower, ag.lab born Ruddington with children Maud, Rose, Hannah and Caroline, on Ruddington Turnpike / High St., Ruddington. Oct.qtr. 1902 Basford district William Yates married Harriett Harrison, widow, hosiery seamer, of Top Row, The Leys, Ruddington. 1911 William age 48 gen.lab in hosiery factory, with wife Harriet age 51 born Ruddington (married 9 years), at 1 Redcliffe Rd., Mansfield, 5-room house. William Yates born 1862 died Jun.qtr. 1931, Mansfield district.

Alice Yates, born 1866, Keyworth. 26 May 1885 Alice Jackson age 19 of Bradmore, daughter of Edward labourer, married William Yates age 22 framework knitter of Bradmore son of William, tailor. 1891 age 25, married to William junior (Bradmore 1891/14). Died 1892, aged 26, buried 16 November 1892.

Maud Yates, born 1886, Bradmore, daughter of William and Alice. 1891 age 5, scholar in parents' house (Bradmore 1891/14). 1901 age 15 in father's house. Methodist Sunday School scholar 4th class 17.10-1.11.1889, 15.6.1890-June 1893, 3rd class July 1893-Dec.1895, 2nd class Jan.1896-June 1898, absent Aug.1897, 1st class July 1898-28.8.1898. 1911 age 25 single cotton worker born Bradmore, in sister Martha Smith's house with her husband Henry, and William Ernest Yates, son of either Martha or Maud.

Rose Yates, born 1888, Ripley, Derbys, daughter of William and Alice. 1891 age 3, scholar in parents' house (Bradmore 1891/14). 1901 age 13 in father's house. Methodist Sunday School scholar Vestry Girls 28.6.1891, 12.7.1891-Dec.1893, 3rd class Jan.1894-15.11.1896.

Alfred Yates born Dec 1888, buried Bunny 2 March 1889 age 3 months, probably son of William and Alice.

(Hannah) Annie Yates, born 1890, Bradmore / Ripley, daughter of William and Alice. 1891 age 1 in parents' house (Bradmore 1891/14). Methodist Sunday School scholar vestry girls 11.2.1894-27.6.1897. 1901 Hannah age 11 in father's house. Hannah Annie Yates of Bradmore married Betram John Coombs of Nottingham at Bunny 3rd October 1908. 1911 Bertram John Coombs 24 basket manufacturer born Nottingham with wife Hannah age 21 born Ripley Derbys (married 2 years with 1 child), daughter Irene Alice age 1 born Nottingham, at 17 Gladstone Terrace, Bunbury St., Nottingham, 4-room house.

Caroline Yates, born Bradmore, bapt. Bunny 18 October 1892, daughter of William, labourer, and Alice of Bradmore. 1901 age 8 recorded twice, in father's house at Ruddington, and in grandparents'

house, William and Martha Yates at Bradmore (Bradmore 19/1901).

Harriet Yates formerly Harrison, born 1860 Ruddington, 2nd wife of William. 1901 age 41, widow, hosiery seamer, with 3 children aged 12 and upwards, at Top Row, The Leys, Ruddington. Married William Yates Oct.qtr. 1902, Basford district. 1911 age 51, married to William, at Mansfield.

Elizabeth Yates born c1864, Ruddington, daughter of William and Martha. 1871 age 6 in parents' house, Ruddington. 1881 age 16 domestic servant for Sarah Hill Hall, widow, on The Green, Ruddington. 1901 age 36, single, in parents' house (Bradmore 19/1901).

Alfred Yates, born 1870, Ruddington, son of William and Martha. 1871 age 1 in parents' house at Ruddington. 1881 age 11, scholar in parents' house (Bradmore 1881/33).

Martha Yates, born 1872, Ruddington, daughter of William and Martha. 1881 age 9, scholar in parents' house (Bradmore 1881/33). Methodist Sunday School scholar 1st class 5.7.1885-17.1.1886, left. 1901 age 29 single, in parents' house (Bradmore 19/1901). Oct.qtr. 1910 Martha Yates married Henry Smith, Basford district. 1911 Henry Smith age 52 joiner born Nottingham with wife Martha age 40 (married 1 year no children), born Ruddington, with "son" (Martha's or Maud's?) William Ernest Yates 10 scholar born Netherfield, and visitor Maud Yates, Martha's sister, at 18 Curzon St., Netherfield, 5-room house.

Henry (Harry) Yates, born 1880/1 Bradmore, son of Arthur and Caroline.

Sarah Yates born 1867 Bradmore nee White, daughter of Edmund and Ann, married Harry Yates 1896 – see White.
